



In The Beginning

It's the beginning of a new month at Redeemer

November 2020

"Faith-Filled & All In: 2021 Annual Giving"

"For we walk by faith, not by sight." (II Corinthians 5:7)

For just a moment, I'd like you to imagine a parish community—one eventually twice as large—whose impact shines the gospel light brighter than ever (St. Matthew 5:16). I am asking all of us to walk by faith.

Imagine a place where hundreds of new members experience changed lives and relationships that are reconciled through worship, formation, and outreach—through grace, in other words. Can you see it? That is the parish God is calling us to build. And the time to start is now. Think of it as the Redeemer we love on steroids. Thankful for the past, and filled with faith for the future, it is time to go all in!

In 2021 we need to lay the groundwork for future and faster growth. And we all need to have a genuine sense of urgency about it. COVID, as bad as it is, has presented an incredible opportunity for our parish (and for Christianity in general). As the world around us continues to be "tossed back and forth by the waves, and blown here and there by every wind of teaching," the timeless, unchanging message of Jesus is more necessary than ever.



In 2021 Redeemer needs to:

- Bring on an additional priest to participate in all areas of parish life (we have been operating with fewer full-time priests since Fr. Rick and Fr. Fred retired)
- · Invest more in digital evangelism, formation for all ages, and communications (did you know dozens of new members discovered and joined Redeemer online during the lockdown?)
- · Strengthen our commitment to outreach, building an even bigger bridge into our community
- Do everything it takes to grow by 200 new members in 2021 (we added 135 new members last year)

We also have plans in 2021 to renovate the music area and to create dedicated space for a growing youth program (more on that later).

Does all of this sound too bold? Is this the wrong time to talk about growth? Is this just the enthusiasm of the new rector talking? I pray not. Make no mistake about it: we are called to make new Christians and to make all Christians new. And, remember, "nothing is impossible with God" (St. Matthew 19:26).
