
CELEBRATE VBS!

RALLY SUNDAY 2024

Our new Sunday School year launches Sunday, August 18, as we welcome Rally Sunday 2024! Parents and children remain in the church at the end of the 9 a.m. mass that morning for information about the year ahead. Then, everyone will have a chance to meet their teachers in Gillespie Hall.

Sunday School is held every Sunday of the academic year from 10--10:40~a.m.

The first class is on August 25. All classrooms, nursery-8th grade, are located on the second floor of the Robinson Center, a secure, controlled-entry building. 9-12th grades meet in the Babcock Youth Center. The parish is blessed with 63 remarkable teachers and leaders who are dedicated to partnering with families to help form the faith foundation of our children and youth ages 2 through 12th grade. These teachers help students deepen their faith, establish solid community values, and foster stronger families along the way. Thank you to each of them!
