Sunday School is back!




Classes are held for VPK (must be 4 years old by September 1, 2024) through 12th grade every Sunday of the academic year after the 9 a.m. mass. Sunday School ends at 10:40 a.m. Students in grades 3 and under must be signed out by an adult. A teacher crew even visits our "Confident Walkers" nursery each week to share a Bible story! Sunday School is also offered in Spanish during the 1 p.m. mass.

The entire parish family is invited to visit all of the Sunday School classrooms on Sunday, September 1, during our Sunday School Open House, following the 9 a.m. mass.

Children's Chapel is offered weekly during the 9 a.m. mass.

Our **nurseries** are for children ages 6 weeks to those who are not yet 4 years old. They are open during the 9 a.m. and 11 a.m. masses on Sundays. Our nursery suite is on the second floor of the Robinson Center.

Sunday School is offered weekly for VPK (for children who are 4 years old by September 1, 2024) through 12th grades. Students go to class immediately after receiving communion at the 9 a.m. mass. VPK-8th grades meets on the second floor of the Robinson Center. High School gathers in the Babcock Youth Center. Classes are also offered at the 1 p.m. mass on Sundays in Spanish.

A Mother's Lounge, for convenience and privacy when nursing babies, is directly across from our nursery suite.
